MASTERS TOURNAMENT RULES

1. USBC certified.
2. The decision of the tournament director shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329. Also USBC Rule 303 (Right to refuse entry) will be in effect.
3. One re-rack per game allowed.
4. Tournament is scratch. All USBC rules are enforced.
5. At least 1 in 5 will cash.
6. Cut will be made to the top 24 or 32 players depending on number of entries. Tournament brackets to be determined by Tournament Manager.
7. Open only to current FW Metro USBC members. Entrants must have a FORT WAYNE METRO USBC average of 12 games as of May 1st in the 2023- 2024 season . Substitute bowler allowed if original bowler confirms entry.
8. Four (4) game qualifier.
9. Alternate player will be asked to return for the second night in case a player who qualifies cannot continue.
10. Lanes will be available for practice at 6:15pm. Practice will be limited to starting lanes and run for 10 mins. Any late players either night will be allowed to bowl IF they get to the lanes and are ready to bowl by the 3rd frame. Zero score for missed frames up to 3rd frame.
During 1st night, bowler on odd lane will move left 2 pair while bowlers on even lane will move right 2 pair after each game until all four games are bowled.
During the 2nd night, bowlers will be pre-assigned lanes for the 1st round of competition.
11. Bowlers will draw for lane assignments at time of check-in.
12. **In Case of a tie in qualifying round for last place an additional tenth frame will be bowled to determine final spot.**
13. **WALK-IN ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ONLY IF SIGN UP NO LATER THAN 6PM, PAY LATE FEE IN CASH OF ADDITIONAL \$10.00 & IF LANES ARE AVAILABLE.**
14. Any new bowling balls manufactured and approved by USBC but NOT worldwide released by May 1st will not be allowed in the competition. The penalty for non-compliance will be immediate disqualification of the bowler for this event.
15. Violation of tournament rules will carry the penalty of disqualification of the bowler with no refund.
